We believe that as the local church we have been called to pray for revival and believe that if we do not ready ourselves that God will pass us by.

We have responded to the call by setting up the Awaken Prayer Movement which will be launched on the 21st January 2019 and continue for 11 weeks.

All Gracepoint leaders are required and expected to take part. All the details pertaining to this Awaken Prayer Movement will be explained on the launch evening.

Leaders will be divided into ten teams, each team will be led by a pastor or elder of Gracepoint. Each team will be delegated a week to pray for revival including a specific theme of prayer associated with readying Gracepoint for a move of the Holy Spirit. The team on duty will meet corporately on the Monday morning of their designated week in the Gracepoint Sanctuary.

Regarding the eleventh week of prayer, all leaders are required to attend the final prayer gathering on the Monday evening in the Gracepoint Sanctuary.

The team on duty for each week will be prayed for daily, each participant by name, by the other leaders and the Prayer Team.

Each leader will receive a journal. This journal will contain each week's theme with relevant verses, sample prayers and questions to meditate upon.

I personally can't wait to see what God has in store for us individually, as the church and as a nation.

The vision I believe is to grow the church through the Awaken Prayer Movement into all the churches across South Africa and wherever the Holy Spirit may lead.

Where there are wounds and scars from the past, whether physical, emotional or spiritual that are keeping them in chains, I ask that by the power of Your Spirit all past harm and traumas would be bound and healed bringing release and freedom.

As the Lord's prayer reminds us, I ask that they would be enabled by Your Spirit to forgive as You forgive. May no unforgiveness remain in their hearts for anyone, including themselves.

Please enable each leader to reject the captivation of sin and temptation in all its forms and may sin have no hold over them.

Father I pray that you would show these leaders any ways or areas in their lives where satan is at work in their lives and where strongholds have formed or are forming. May they abandon those areas and ways and may all territory be taken back from satan and placed under the lordship of Jesus. Where their ancestors and fathers' households have called upon powers that set themselves up in opposition to Jesus Christ, I ask that they would reject these powers and that You would break that power over them and their households. Deliver them from all evil.

For Yours is the kingdom, the power and the glory. Forever and ever. Amen
