### What's happening at GAP?

Over the month of November at Gracepoint it is customary to spend time, celebrating and acknowledging special moments as a family, which includes moments of healing, remembrance and thanksgiving. At GAP we would like to encourage you to engage these moments with your children as a family together, as we pause to come close to God.

### Sunday 1 November: Healing

Today at GAP our focus is on healing as we look at Luke 17:11-19, by using Godly play style learning and wondering.

We can read the account of Jesus healing 10 lepers. Through this story we wonder about healing and ask the questions: who do you know that needs healing and if they were to be healed like the lepers, would you come back to say thank you?

Please send time praying for those you know need healing and working through the wondering questions supplied in this resource.

### Family Time:

1. Start off by reading today's scripture again: Luke 17:11-19.
2. Then, we would like to encourage that you discuss the following wondering questions together as a family:
  - I wonder what it would have been like to be a leper and never be allowed to go near other people?
  - I wonder why people were afraid of going near the lepers?
  - I wonder how the lepers had heard about Jesus?

- I wonder how the lepers felt when they were healed?
  - I wonder why the other nine lepers didn't come back to say thank you?
  - I wonder what the leper who came back, said to Jesus?
  - I wonder what you would have said to Jesus?
  - I wonder what is it that you need healing for today?
  - I wonder who know that needs God's healing?
  - I wonder if you have ever come so close to Jesus like the lepers did for healing?
  - I wonder if you have ever asked God to heal someone or a situation?
  - I wonder if you did or will come back to say thank you?
  - I wonder what you think we need to do with this story today?
3. On the next page you will find an example of an activity you can do with your family, which is linked to their GAP lesson on Luke 17:11-19 on Jesus healing the 10 lepers. A similar picture could be created by you and your family.
  4. Then once the picture has been created, label each finger of the hand (representing both a leper and a person in need of healing) with the name of someone or something you would like to ask God for healing for.
  5. Then, we would like to encourage you to spend time praying using the picture you have created, going through each finger and asking God for healing for that person or situation.
